Help us end homelessness locally by making a regular donation:

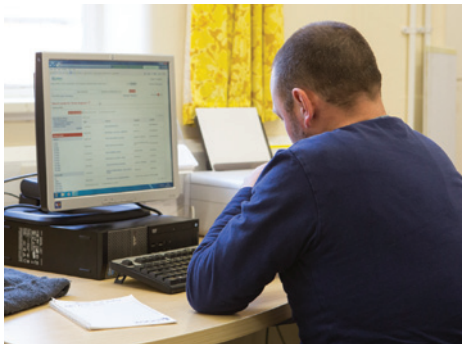
£5 Could provide one homeless person with a clothing and toiletries pack.

● Give as you earn

Payroll Giving, also known as workplace giving, is a great way to make regular donations to the Friary straight from your pay.

Any donation you make is taken from your pre-tax pay and therefore reduces the amount of tax you pay. This means the actual cost to you of the donation is less than the amount we as a Charity will receive. See the table below for examples:
