Help us end homelessness locally by making a regular donation:

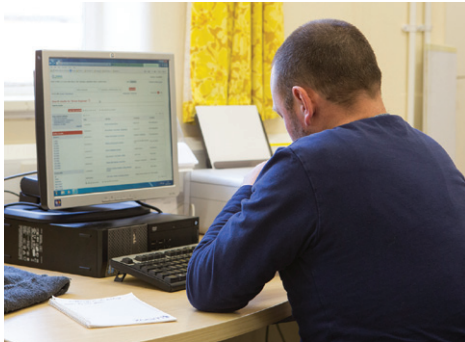
**£5** Could provide one homeless person with a clothing and toiletries pack.
